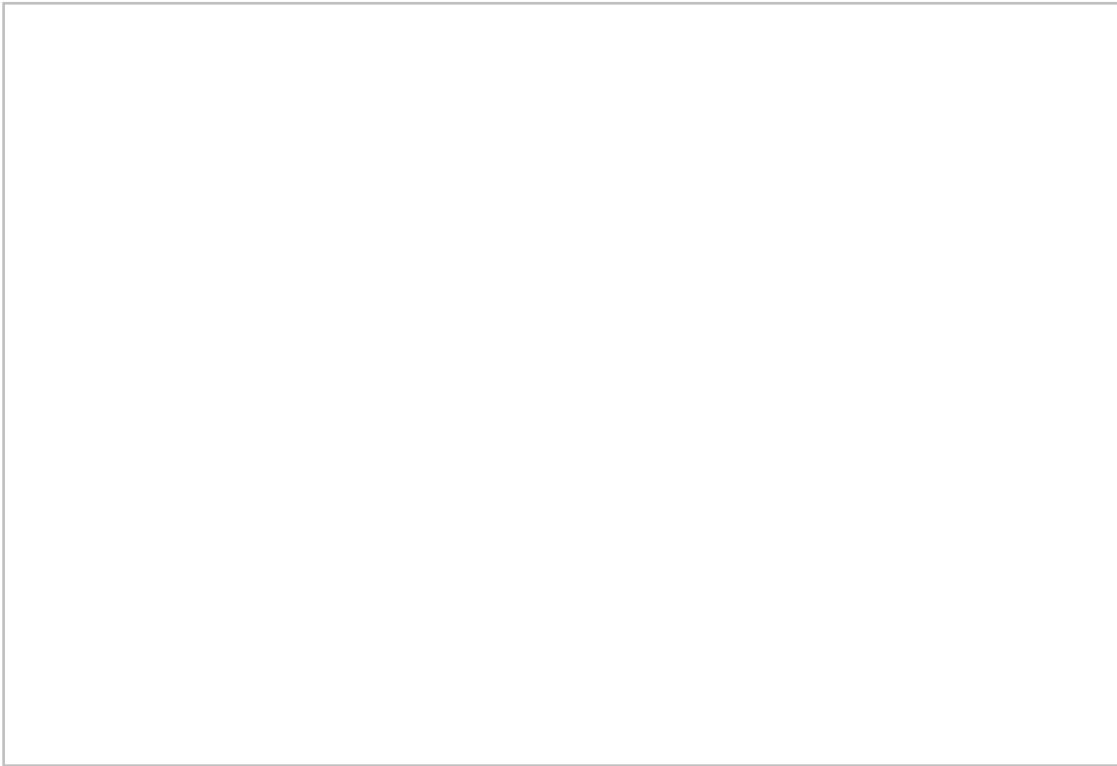

It has been a while but we are nearly complete with the geophysical survey for the Helios solar scheme. There has been a slight change to the redline boundary (attached) but the majority is a reduction in site area. There is one area of slight increase as marked in yellow on the attached plan but given the location of this, its route along the road and then within an area which has seen modern disturbance, we have not included it in the geophys survey area.



Green are the areas we have surveyed. There are some fields in this original area which are no longer in the redline boundary – that is field 59 and 60 and 61 and 62, meaning there is only fields 30, 31 and 58 to be surveyed.

I am hoping for an interim report within the next few days but in the meantime, and for your information, I will send you a link to the .kmz files to upload into google earth which shows the greyscales of what has been uncovered thus far.

If you could let me know if you get this link and can access the files, as if you cant ill get them to you another way!
